

Pocket Money & Other Boarding Requirements

➤ Pocket money

Monies should be paid into the student's school account.

The suggested amounts are as follows:

- Minimum R300 per month for Town trip-to purchase toiletries
- Maximum R100 per week spending money for tuck shop

On average students use about **R2000,00** per term for pocket money.

➤ Devices/ gadgets

Students can bring devices/ gadgets to school. Juniors will only be allowed to use their devices during weekends. However, with the current learning environment this condition is flexible to accommodate their learning needs.

➤ Other Essential Requirements

We would advise parents to purchase the following items:

- 2 study pad locks – for cupboard lockers (luggage locks are not acceptable)
- Water bottle
- Cutlery and a cereal bowl for use in the hostel and or trips (please note that the dining hall provides cutlery for meals at the dining hall only)
- Laundry bag (to be purchased from the school uniform shop)
- Umbrella / raincoat (black or navy) for rainy weather
- Students are encouraged to bring their own duvets sets to encourage individualisation
- Single bed waterproof mattress protector (MP92cm)
- X10 coat hangers/clothes hangers

➤ Personalised COVID-19 Requirements

- Face Masks (preferably disposable)
- Personal / pocket hand sanitiser
